ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Bachelor's degree or equivalent from an accredited institution in any fields.
2. English Proficiency
3. Experience is a plus.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. A completed application form
2. Official transcript of the previous university attended (1 copy)
3. Bachelor's Degree Certificate (1 copy)
4. Citizen identification card and residence registration for Thai applicants (1 copy)
5. Passport for non-Thai applicants (1 copy)
6. Three (1 X 1.5-inch size) Photographs (photo in gown not essential)
7. Resume (1 copy)

Note : All documents must be endorsed with signature and submitted in person within the last day of application period, otherwise the application will not be considered and the applicant will not be allowed to sit for the Admission interview.

Applicants who are graduates from overseas Universities will be required to provide at the time of applying and not later, certified, attested, or notarized by competent notaries, all academic documents with the seal or stamp by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Education or related department.

ADMISSION FEE 1,000 THB (English Proficiency Test and Interview) (Non-refundable)

EXEMPTION

The AU English Proficiency Test can be exempted depending on which of the following conditions you satisfy.

- a TOEFL score of at least (iBT) 90 or (PBT) 575 or an IELTS (Academic) score of at least 6.5 (Validation: Two years)
- a Bachelor's degree or a higher degree from native English speaking countries (e.g. USA, Canada, UK, and New Zealand)
